In terms of the Schedule Update, two parent talks were held. The second on was attended by 67 students and the Chair of the School Committee (who has a child at the school). ### Some questions/comments:

- Is there a variety of students in the focus groups? 9-12 is represented.
- Class Failures are up 3X.
- Student of one member likes the new schedule because there is less asynchronous time.
- What is the purpose of the 20 minute Friday classes?

## Hybrid Reentry:

Dec. 2 is first day of hybrid (cohort A).

Nov. 30 is a COVID-19 testing day for students and any staff who traveled over the holiday.

#### Some questions/comments:

- One member stated she would prefer the testing to not be optional. Wonders if the wording can be changed to be more firm/encouraging?
- One member mentions that some districts have families sign behavior contracts.
- This is a community effort.
- The only acceptable test is the PCR. We will be going to pool testing.
- PCR is the most effective. The rapid test is only 60% effective. The take home test is not as effective.

The Hybrid Protocols draft version was shared.

We will continue to follow the remote schedule on Monday 11/30 and Tuesday 12/1.

Joel and Stephanie will put together an agenda before the next meeting, which is on 12/16/2020.

A student support assembly was held last week for the 9th graders. Topics included: grades, transcripts, supports available...

One member states that freshman really need support.

More transparency of grades is needed.
